Must have or be willing to obtain Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA) – Provisional certification within the first six months of employment. Preferred knowledge of community-based recovery services, substance use disorder counseling, and family systems.

Must have valid NYS license and method of transportation. Must be addiction free, including tobacco. Pre-employment background/post offer drug screening required for external candidates. This is an hourly nonexempt position. EOE
