REGISTERED NURSE (RN) - COUNTY JAIL PROGRAM

Reporting Relationship:

Reports to: Director or Senior Services Director or his/her designee.

Duties:

RN (1.5 FTE's) Corrections Nurses provide care to inmate patients to promote and improve their overall health utilizing the nursing process in triage, professional training and various resources in accordance with regulatory agencies and established guidelines. The inmate patient population generally has not had consistent access to healthcare prior to their incarceration. This provides an opportunity for nurses to see and care for an interesting variety of health concerns from minor ailments or major and atypical conditions. Under general supervision, they deliver care to patients utilizing the nursing process of assessment, planning, intervention, implementation, and evaluation, in accordance with established philosophy. RNs collaborate with other professional disciplines to ensure effective patient care deliver and achievement of desire patient outcomes. RNs effective interact with patients, while maintaining the standard of professional nursing.

Pre-employment background/post offer drug screening required. Must be free of active addiction, including tobacco. Valid NYS driver's license and method of transportation required. This is a salaried non-exempt position. EOE
