DIRECTOR OF RECOVERY SERVICES

SUPERVISION

Under the direct supervision of the Executive Director and the Director of Project Innovation and Expansion (PIE), the Director of Recovery Services oversees the development and monitoring of recovery-based projects of Genesee/Orleans Council on Alcoholism and Substance Abuse, Inc. (GCASA).

RESPONSIBILITIES

Oversees the development, implementation, and evaluation of recovery-based grant and non-grant services, including work plans and other quality systems. Ensure continuity with all other internal systems across all programs and locations associated with each new and innovative recovery-based project. Develop collaborative relationships with external stakeholders and payers. Understands the needs of staff, referral sources, other substance use disorder professionals and target audiences in such a way as to obtain support, cooperation and shared understanding of the common expectations, requirements and goals which enhance recovery services. Develops and articulates a model of the unique problems and dynamics that each new recovery-based service will encounter, so as to communicate and solve those problems across GCASA's delivery system. Obtains, organizes and evaluates resources necessary to carry out each recovery-based project. In collaboration with other staff, participate in any grant writing as needed and develop and implement an evaluation component for each project ascribing to the payers and/or stakeholders standards. Contributes to the knowledge base of the agency and the profession by reflecting on and articulating practice experience in such a way as to teach and assist staff and other service providers in how to best articulate each recovery-based service as it relates to the mission of the organization. At times, you may be requested by your supervisor or equivalent to perform tasks outside of your job description.

QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum requirements: Bachelor's degree in related field, 1-3 years of grant development and implementation, minimum 3 years in high level supervisory capacity, a broad understanding of recovery-based services within the SUD delivery system. Must have valid NYS license and method of transportation. Must be addiction free, including tobacco. Pre-employment background/post offer drug screening required. EOE
